Ideas on how to support your child's learning at home.

These are the topics we will be learning:

English

Fiction—Stories from another culture: Children will be reading *Handa's Surprise*. They will create a story map of the story and use Pie Corbett actions to help them remember the story. They will then create their own version of the story, changing the fruits and animals in the story.

Non-Fiction: Recount: Children will be learning about the features of recount. They will then write a recount about our school trip to the farm.

Numeracy:

Number:

The children will continue learning about the place value of numbers up to 50. They will be learning to read and write numbers up to 50 in words and numerals. They will also be learning to partition numbers into tens and units, for example, $36 = 3 \text{ tens and } 6 \text{ units}$.

The children are continuing to learn their number bonds to 20. Please help your child learn them.

Measurement—Length, height, weight and volume.

The children will be learning to compare the 4 measurements using comparative language, such as, taller, tallest, longer, shorter, heavier and lighter. They will be using specific equipment to measure, for example, a ruler to measure the length of objects.

Topic: On the farm

The children will be learning that vegetables are grown in the ground and fruits are grown on plants, bushes and trees. They will be exploring where our food comes from, for example, eggs come from hens, milk comes from cows etc. They will be learning that some food are grown in the UK and some are grown in other countries. They will move onto learning about farm animals and the difference between them and wild animals. They will learn the names for the young of farm animals (e.g. lamb, calf).

R.E: The children will be learning about the Easter story and the important lessons Christian people learn from this story.

PHSE: Be Safe—The children will be thinking about making decisions and how it affects themselves and those around them. They will also think about peer pressure and assertiveness. Talk to the children about making good choices and think of ways to work well with others.

PE: Dance

The children will look at different styles of dance and be given the opportunity to come up with their own sequences to create their own dances.

D&T: Wood

This half-term, the children will take part in a D&T day, working with the material- wood on **Wednesday 20th March 2019**.
