Bug club: What is bug club?

A reading programme that Old Palace are using to help teach reading from reception to year 4. Children can take home a reading book as well as accessing an eBooks version via a personalised website. Children can enjoy reading books onscreen and completing fun quiz questions found in the eBooks. The quiz questions will help the children practise their reading skills. Children can read at their own pace. Encourage your child to attempt all quizzes. We can track their progress and help them with types of quiz questions they struggle with. Allow your child to read a favourite eBook again. When can children use the eBooks? If you have access to an internet connection at home, your child can log on whenever they want to, from home.
