

Year 3: Spring 2 (February & March)

Topic: Settlements & Rivers (Humanities)

- Can you tell me what things made a site a good place for a settlement in olden times? (food, farming, river, woodland for fuel and building materials, shelter & defence)
- Why did the Romans build London by the Thames? What was London originally called? (Londinium)
- Can you tell me some ways in which London has changed over the centuries?
- Where do rivers flow to? Why are they important?
- Can you name some parts of a river system? (source, stream, valley, meander, tributary, flood plain, mouth, estuary, river bed, river bank)
- Where does the Thames start? (Cirencester)
- Which sea does it flow into? (North Sea)
- Can you name some settlements on the Thames? (Oxford, Reading, Henley-on-Thames, Windsor)
- Why is the Thames so important to the people in London? (water, transport, trade, leisure)
- What are the seas around the United Kingdom?
- Can you name a city on each of these rivers and say which sea they flow into: Tay, Trent, Tyne, Severn, Mersey, Clyde?
- Can you tell me some cities in the UK and where they are located in relation to each other? (e.g. Birmingham is North West of Milton Keynes)
- Can you tell me what urban and rural mean?
- How are cities connected to each other?
- Can you tell me how to create a sketch map?
- What does fieldwork mean? How did we use it?
- How is land used in a city area like Bow?
- How is land used in a village like Eynsford?
- What are the similarities and differences in the way land is used in cities and villages?
- What problems do litter cause?
- Whose responsibility is it to keep our area litter free?

Computing: Filming a news report

- What things are needed to film a news report?
- What **software** can you use to **edit** a video?
- How can you **add titles** to a video?
- How can you **add music** to a video?

French: Ma Famille

- Which members of your family can you name? (*mes parents, mon père, ma mère, mon frère, ma soeur, mon dragon*)
- How will you introduce your family members? (*Voici/voilà ma mère. Elle s'appelle Molly*)
- Can you describe your family members? (*Elle est sympa. Il est bavard. Elle est bavarde.*)
- Can you ask your partner to describe family members? (*C'est qui?*)

Music – African Drumming

- Can you sing or play a drum expressively in time to a beat?
- Are you able to name a range of drums and their country of origin? (e.g. Africa: djembe Cuba: conga India: tabla Ireland: bodhran)
- Can you name any different drumming genres (e.g. Marching band, orchestral, drum and bass) and name a piece of Djembe/Tembe music? (e.g. Jubilate Deo, Che Che Kule, Ranky Tank.)
- Can you name any famous composers/drummers/master drummers from around the world? (e.g. Stewart Copeland, Bolokada Conde, Drissa Kone)

DT: Fabric

- How did you add decoration to your purse?
- How did you join your leather to make your purse?
- How did you come up with your design?
- Does your purse match your design?

RE: Judaism (continuation)

- What are the key areas of the **synagogue** and why are these important to believers?
- Name the Jewish practices at **Chanukah**
- How do they help Jews reflect on important aspects of the story of **Chanukah**?
- What foods are found on a **Seder** plate?
- How does the food help people remember the festival of **Pesach**?
