Dear Parents/carers,

On **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October, Year 6** will be attending the '**Children's University**' graduation ceremony at **Bow Schools Riverside Theater** from **13:30** until **15:00/15:15**.

As you are aware, the children took part in the project last year, gathering points and codes for all the learning and activities they did outside of the classroom. The children did a great job attending afterschool clubs (inside and outside of school), completing activities at home (such as baking or community work) and being adventurous (such as bike riding or taking big long walks through nature). Many of the children even earned lots of points by attending the year 5 residential trip!

The children collected their points using the online Children's University Dashboard, and worked towards unlocking the Bronze medal. As they progressed, they also unlocked achievements and stamps for their efforts and hard work.

It is now time for us to celebrate their achievements with a graduation ceremony for their Bronze year on the project!

During the graduation ceremony, the children will either be awarded with a certificate of participation, or a certificate of completion for the bronze medal! Throughout year 6, the children will have time to earn more codes and point with their extracurricular learning and activities to see if they can unlock the next medal!
