Our Topic: My School

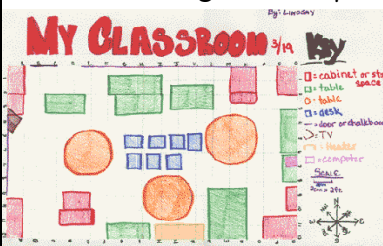

Project 2: How schools have changed over time.

Due Monday 5th December

Create a project to share your learning about how schools have changed since the 1900s (Victorian times). Things to think about that have changed over time:

- Buildings
- School Rules
- School Timetable
- Playground games/toys
