Year 3 Research Projects

Our Topic: Ancient Britian and Stonehenge

This half term, Year 3 will be learning about Ancient Britian and Stonehenge. Children will be learning about what Stonehenge is and how people believe it came to be built. Children will also be looking at the different uses of Stonehenge and how the way it casts shadows may have been used to help tell time. Children will also learn about different animals and ways of life in Anceint Britian. They will at the way Ancient British people were hunters and gatherers and some of the tools they may have used.

Here are some activities for your child to complete linked to our topic.

Project 1: Stonehenge Due Monday 21st November

Create a project to share your learning about Stonehenge. What is stonehenge? How do people believe it was built? What do people believe stonehenge was used for? What have you learnt about shadows? How might people use the shadows cast by stongehenge to tell time?



Project 2: Prehistoric Animals Due Monday 5th December



Create a project to share your learning about the different prehistoric animals that could be found in Ancient Britian. What animals were there? What were they used for? Where did they live? What did they look like? What did they eat? What other interesting facts did you find out about them?

Think about how you want to present your learning. Will you choose to create a model, write a fact file, make a posster or maybe something else? How you choose to present your information is up to you!
