## **Open Classes**

### **Children in RB, RP, 2B & 2H should attend school as normal**

The trip for the children in 2B to the Horniman Museum, will go ahead as planned.

Children should arrive by 9am and will be dismissed at 3.30pm as usual.

Breakfast Club will remain open for these children, but there will be no after school clubs on Wednesday.

## **Closed Classes**

## **Vulnerable Pupils**

The school will remain open for pupils who are classified as 'vulnerable'. These are SEND pupils with an EHCP and children with an allocated social worker.

A text was sent to these families on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> January, to confirm that their child/ren could attend school on the strike day. If you received this text then your child is able to attend on Wednesday, even if their class is closed for the day. A special provision will be set up for this group of children run by senior leaders.
