Maths

Please see below the order of the topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

- 1. **Place Value** Children will be practicing counting and representing objects to 100, looking at tens and ones using a place value chart, comparing and ordering numbers as well as counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.
- 2. Addition and Subtraction Children will be looking at related addition and subtract facts, checking and comparing number sentences, knowing their bonds to 100, finding 10 more or less, as well as adding and subtracting 2-digit and 1-digit numbers
