Maths

Please see below the order of the topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

- 1. **Place Value** Children will be revising their knowledge of place value in 6-digit numbers, rounding and negative numbers.
- 2. Four Operations Children will be practising written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, using estimating and checking strategies to ensure their answers are correct and problem solving with all four operations.
- **3.** Fractions Children will learn to use all four operations using fractions and apply their knowledge when problem solving.
