Maths

Please see below the maths topics this half term:

- Multiplication Children will begin the unit by looking at making equal groups, adding equal groups and then linking this to multiplication. Children will look at making multiplication sentences and using arrays to show these. The children will be looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Division Children will begin by again looking at making equal groups and then move on to looking at sharing and grouping equally for division. They will be looking at dividing by 2, 5 and 10 and using a bar model to do so. Children will also practise odd and even numbers.

Please see below the order of topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

- Stories from a range of Cultures Children will begin the unit by reading and exploring the story 'Mama Panya's Pancakes', they will also have the chance to listen to and explore stories from other cultures during their story time. They will then get the chance to write their own story.
