Maths

Please see below the maths topics this half term:

- Multiplication and Division- The unit will begin by looking at multiples, factors, prime numbers, square numbers and cubed numbers. The children will then go on to practicing using the written methods for short multiplication and division.
- 2. **Properties of Shapes** The unit will begin by looking at using a protractor to measure angles in degrees. Children will then look at drawing, lines and angles accurately and calculating different angels around a point and in a shape. The unit will also look at parallel and perpendicular lines.
