
YEAR 5: Spring 1 2024

The children have completed the following learning this half term


English



The children began this half term by looking at legend stories, the features that are included and had independently planned and wrote their own legend stories based on King Arthur.

They then looked at newspapers and their features and wrote their own newspaper article which they published dressed as news anchors.

Maths



This half term, Year 5 investigated how to multiply 2 digit numbers by 3 digit numbers and divide 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers. They learn how to use different methods to do this. They also explored angles and how to measure angles as well as properties of shapes.

Topic



Our topic this half term has been what Britain became where the children learnt about Anglo Saxons and the vikings, how times were different then compared to now and how certain places in England were named how they were.



To support their learning the children visited the British museum where they visited the room on Anglo saxons and the vikings to help support their learning.



To consolidate their learning, they completed a **Make it Real** project which involved the children doing a mock trial in anglo saxon times.


Other Subjects

The theme for **PHSE** was Dreams and goals. Children focused on what their goals and dreams were and how they could achieve them. They also compared different children's dreams and goals around the world and how they differ.

Our topic for **RE** was "Can we live by the values of Jesus in the 21st Century?" where the children studied in a detailed way some teachings of Jesus and the way they are applied today. The children considered examples of what Jesus said and how christians today responded to the challenges of his teachings.

In **PE**, the children have been learning Dance and hockey. For Dance the children have been learning different bollywood dance moves and have developed their skills for line dancing. For outdoor PE the children have been learning hockey where they developed their skills such as quick footwork, passing, moving into space and shooting.
