The children have completed the following learning this half term


English



This half term in English we have been looking at contemporary fiction texts. We read books related to mental health: "My mum's from Pluto" and "My dad's a birdman". We discussed how the reader could relate to the characters and the challenges they face and wrote our own diary entry based on the main character's experiences. In our writing we used adverbs and adverbial phrases as well as dashed and semi-colons.

We have also looked at explanation, instruction and report texts. We wrote our own information text on maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

In Maths we have learnt about angles in quadrilaterals, triangles and polygons. We have learnt how to measure, draw and find missing angles. We have also learnt about properties of 2D and 3D shape, order of operations (BIDMAS) and practised calculating ratio and proportion.

Topic: Fit for Life



Our topic this half term was "Fit for life". We learned about the structure of the brain and the various functions of its different parts, as well as circulatory and respiratory system. We explored what is needed to keep our heart healthy and why are the nutrients essential for our bodies. We also looked at how to stay healthy through balanced diets and exercise. We conducted our own investigation where we measured our heart before, during and after exercise.
