#### Maths

Please see below the order of the topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

**Decimals** – Identifying tenths and hundredths including multiplying and dividing decimals by 10 and 100, writing decimal numbers, comparing, ordering & rounding decimals and solving problems involving decimal numbers.

**Money** – Understanding the value of money linked to decimals (tenths and hundredths), ordering, rounding and estimating using money and solving problems involving money.

Please see below the order of topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

**Letter writing** – Children will explore the features of a letter and understand how to set out a letter formally. They will then write their own letter. Throughout the unit, the children will develop their ability to write a range of letters and to explore how language changes depending on the intended audience.

**Historical Fiction** – The children will be reading the story '*A long walk to water'* by Linda Sue Park, which is the story of Salva's resilience and continued efforts to help people. We will then be looking at the features of a diary and children will practise writing their own diary extracts.
