
YEAR 5: Spring 2 2024

The children have completed the following learning this half term


English



In English this half term, the children have read 'Gansta Granny' by David Walliams. They then planned and wrote their own humour stories about a grandparent who goes on a hilarious adventure in a London museum.

We have also looked at persuasive articles and the children have written their own persuasive text, informing the reader of the dangers of plastic pollution and encouraging them to reduce, reuse and recycle.


Maths



In Maths this half term, we have been looking at fractions. The children have converted between mixed numbers and improper fractions, added and subtracted and multiplied fractions and solved problems involving fractions.

We have also looked at translation and reflection of shapes and using coordinates to describe these.

Topic: Materials



For their topic, the children learned about materials. We discussed which the different properties of materials and which materials are best for different purposes. We also carried out investigations into the strength, flexibility, durability, transparency and whether materials are waterproof. Ina addition, we investigated using filtration to separate materials.



To support their learning the children visited the Soane Centre and explored different materials and their properties.



To consolidate their learning, they completed a **Make it Real** project which involved using old items to create something new.


Other Subjects
