



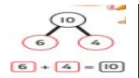

Maths

Please see below the order of the topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

- Place Value-** In this unit, the children begin by sorting and grouping objects up to 10. They then count to 10 and focus on 'one more' and 'one less' before learning how to use a number line to count on and back. They will also be introduced to the 'part-whole' model, focusing on different ways of portioning numbers up to 10.
- Addition and Subtraction-** This unit focuses on number bonds within 10 and number bonds to 10. They will also be introduced to the idea of 'count all' and 'count on'. Subtraction will be a focus in Autumn 2.

Please see below the order of topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

Traditional Tales- The unit will introduce the children to stories with predictable and patterned language. They will identify the beginning, middle and end and discuss the characters, ending by writing a character profile for Goldilocks.

Familiar Settings- Using the book 'Lima's Red Hot Chili', the children will discuss familiar experiences and linking this to their own experiences.

Labels, Lists and Captions- The children will continue to develop their understanding of complete sentences and the use of capital letters and full stops.
