Maths

Please see below the order of the topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

- 1. **Place Value** Children will be reading and rounding numbers to 10, 000, counting in 10, 000's, finding 1000 more or less and reading, identifying and counting in negative numbers. They will also be comparing numbers up to 10, 000
- 2. Addition and Subtraction Children will be adding and subtracting with numbers up to 10, 00, including two five digit numbers. They will also be rounding numbers to the nearest 100 and 1000. All of this will help them with problem solving fort addition and subtraction.

They will develop their understanding of how figurative language is used in a range of poems, old and new, and will apply this in their own writing using MORERAPS (metaphor, onomatopoeia, rhyme, emotion, repetition, alliteration, personification and simile).

Mystery - The children will write a detective story in which a theft takes place. A reversal will be used to cast suspicion on another suspect until the villain is finally revealed at the end of the story.
