Maths

Please see below the order of the topics the children will be focusing on this half term:

- Place Value-** Children will be practicing counting in 50s and 100s, representing numbers up to 1,000, identifying 100s, 10s, and 1s, using a number line, and comparing and ordering numbers.
- Addition and Subtraction** - Children will be practising adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers, looking at addition and subtraction patterns, estimating answers to addition and subtraction, using checking strategies and problem solving.
