FOOD DONATION BOX ESSENTIALS

We purchase most of the food that we give out and the below list provides core non-perishable items that we spend money on most weeks. We will give out any donations outside of this list as additional extras. We require items are non-perishable, in date, unopened, and labelled with their nutritional information.

- Tinned fish / Tinned meat
- Tinned vegetables and pulses – kidney beans, chickpeas, tomatoes, sweetcorn etc. (400 g)
- Cereals
- Disposable nappies (most popular sizes: 5 & 6)
- Dried lentils
- Vegetable cooking oil (1 L)
- UHT Milk (semi-skimmed or full fat)
- Rice (500g - 1 kg)
- Pasta (500g - 1 kg)
- Instant coffee
- Teabags
- Peanut butter
- Sweet spread (jam, honey etc.)
- Tinned rice pudding
- Tinned custard
- Wraps
- Nuts / Seeds / Dried fruit
- Period products
- Incontinence pads
- Shower gel
- Shampoo
- Toothpaste
- Washing-up liquid
- Washing powder
- Toilet rolls

Bow Foodbank is a local Tower Hamlets charity. We provide emergency food supplies to those who are in crisis due to financial difficulties. We aim to offer food to those in need in a friendly and hospitable way. There is no need for a referral or booking.
