Maths

Please see below the maths topics this half term:

- **1. Money** The unit will begin with identify the different coins and notes and counting different amounts of money. The children will then look at finding change and making equal amounts.
- **2. Multiplication** Children will begin the unit by looking at making equal groups, adding equal groups and then linking this to multiplication. Children will look at making multiplication sentences and using arrays to show these. The children will be looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times
- **3. Division** Children will begin by looking at making equal groups and then move on to looking at sharing and grouping equally for division. They will be looking at dividing by 2, 5 and 10 and using a bar model to do so. Children will also practise odd and even numbers.
