I loved all of the activities, but my favourites were the zipline and the water roller. Using the water roller we had to work as a team to make it roll across the water, it was so fun! " "I really liked going to Thriftwood and climbing up the ladder in the ladder climb. At first it was tricky and I wanted to go back down, but I kept going and made it to the top." They had the opportunity to take part in a range of sports and physical activities including: caving, vertical obstacle course, bushcraft and laser combat.</p>  <p>Pupil quotes: " At Stubbers, you have an obstacle course where you climb up it and there will be 4 main courses to complete: a log, tyres, a rope and a high jump. It really tests your stamina and strength." " At Stubbers, we did lazer tag. I really enjoyed ducking and diving and being tactical" "At Stubbers I enjoyed caving because there was a ball pit and different routes to choose. It also helped me to conquer my fear of the dark".</p>

Actual Spend: £780	<p>60 wrist bands were purchased and trialled with our Year 5 pupils. The children wore the wrist bands during running session, which allowed a class score to be generated. This increased participation as the classes then competed against each other.</p> <p>Pupil Quotes: "Moki bands are fun and competitive. In the PE it is the best part as you can track the hard work you do. It also helps me to set a goal to work towards" "The Moki band is like a watch that records my steps. I like it because I like to compete with my friends, especially in PE. I also see how many steps I have done so I can improve every day to get healthier."</p>
